Lieutenant Oliver Royal Flying Corps who has been at the front for some time returned home for a few days leave. He was paying a visit to some friends at Willows, Upper Colwall when he was suddenly taken ill and died after only three days illness. He was buried at the parish church with full military honours, men of the Worcestershire Regiment forming the firing party.
